

CPAC UPDATE NOVEMBER 13, 2020

We greatly appreciate all who have supported CPAC by their presence at one of our many concerts and those who have provided financial contributions to help set the stage for a long and bright future.

Please view the list of protocols and policies below to help prepare you for your experience at CPAC this year. Ongoing adjustments and decisions will be made following recommendations from state and local officials.

*Previously purchased seat assignments may need to be adjusted to allow for increased distancing

**Concerts may be moved to the CPAC patio when weather permits

- All guests and staff are required to wear a mask during their time at the CPAC facility
- Seating is limited to 40% theater capacity
- Temperatures of indoor concert attendees will be checked using a non-touch thermometer
- All tickets must be purchased prior to the performance as door sales will not be available
- CPAC events will be conducted without intermission or concession service
- Guests are welcome to bring water
- Patrons may move to an empty seat if it provides increased distancing
- Patrons will exit the venue one row at a time from front to back
- CPAC follows state cleaning protocols and hand sanitizer is available throughout the venue
- Remember to wear a face cover, wash your hands frequently and stay home if you are sick

While we will be making our best effort to ensure a clean and safe environment, it is impossible to eliminate all risks of infection. Please consider your own individual circumstance and make the decision that is in your best interest, even if it means staying home.

CPAC continues to offer a no-risk guarantee for all ticket purchases to our 2020-2021 season. In the event that you are not ready to return to CPAC, your event is canceled, or you are not well, you may obtain credit for a future performance, receive a full refund, or donate your ticket back to CPAC as a tax-deductible gift.
