Watercolor Paints:

- Hansa Yellow
- Cadmium Orange
- Permanent Rose
- Cobalt Blue
- Ultramarine Blue
- Sap Green or Hookers Green
- Raw Sienna
- Burnt Sienna

Brushes

- #8 round
- 1" Flat or pointed oval Royal Langnickel Zen 83 Series from Michaels is great

Paper: Cold Watercolor Block, 9" x 12" or larger, 140lb

Travel stool

Roberta's notes about easels: A lightweight plein air easel is great but is not totally necessary as sketches are more casual. For the indoor studio work, a table easel is helpful, but boards can be propped up for the usual 15-degree angle good for watercolor.
