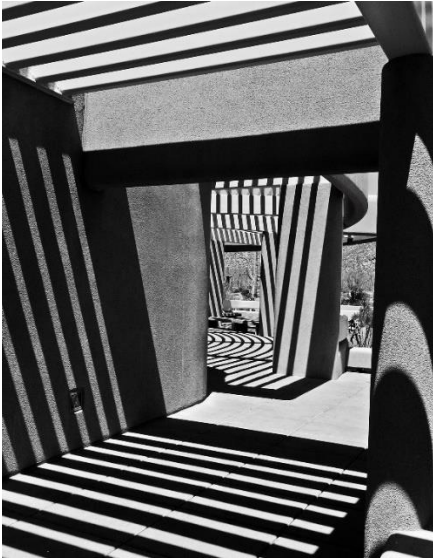




Vision

CPAC ART SHOW 2020

CPAC is pleased to announce a photography exhibition: **Vision**. Artists working in all photographic media and styles are asked to submit experimental and mixed-media photographic techniques in addition to traditional photographs. The goal of this show is to celebrate the creativity and skills of photographers who convey their vision using their favorite practices. Photographers can enter work in any genre. All images must be two-dimensional and start in **your** camera (film or digitally). Photos can be altered using traditional and digital processes as well as infrared shooting, composites, mixed media and/or post processing.

Photographers are invited to participate in this juried exhibition at CPAC. Each artist can submit up to three pieces. The entry fee is \$30. All artworks must be for sale. CPAC will retain 25% of the sales & handle the paperwork. Please remember this as you price your work on your entry form. **Artists agree to pay CPAC their 25% commission on any work displayed during the exhibit that is sold within 30 days after take-down of the show.**

Prizes: First Place - \$300, Second Place - \$200, Third Place - Three Honorable Mentions \$100,

Finn returned to Tucson to open her own commercial studio. Several years later she opened Photographic Works, a photo and fine art lab. Finn evolved her company keeping up with the industry as major changes in technology happened. Finn recently felt that after many years it was time for change. Finn has transformed Photographic Works into something new and is no longer a lab. PW now hosts workshops, and gallery events. It is also a creative space with a library. Finn is focused on her own work as well as creating space for photographers and artists to share ideas and community.

ARTWORK ELIGIBILITY

Photographers are invited to submit up to 3 individual pieces, provided they meet the following requirements:

- All work must be **ORIGINAL**, designed and created by the applicant.
- All work must have been completed within the past three years.

- The entire assemblage should not exceed 20 lbs in weight.
- Size - no more than 9 sq. ft. e. g., 36" x 36"
- Photographs mounted on gallery wrap canvas (framed and unframed); printed on metal, acrylic, glass, leather and wood will be accepted provided they are designed as a wall hanging and ready to hang.
 - Hanging hardware shall consist of stranded or coated wire passed twice through screw eyes and twisted at least eight times or attached with a ferrule.
 - The screw eyes should be approximately 1/3 down from the top of the artwork, and the wire 2-4" from the top of the artwork when stretched taught.
 - Use saw tooth hangers for cradle boards since they will be hung on nails.
- Artwork must be dry and odor free.
- All work must be available for display for the full duration of the exhibit.
- Due to the sensitivities that must be considered in a public environment, CPAC reserves the right to refuse the display of any materials that contain obscenity, nudity, religious, mythological and/or metaphysical symbolism or pieces that may impose a threat of physical harm to patrons.

- Application due with checks made out to CPAC by October 24, 2023. (Address on Entry Form)
- Include a biography and/or artist statement with application to be displayed in a notebook during the exhibition.
- Work to be received in CPAC's gallery on Wednesday, November 1st from 10:00 AM – 11:00 AM.

- Jurying will take place on Wednesday, November 1st from 12:00 – 2:00 PM at CPAC.
- Notification of acceptance of work will take place on Wednesday, November 1st from 2:00 PM – 3:00 PM via e-mail. (Phone calls will only be made to artists who do not have an e-mail address). Artwork not selected for the exhibit should be picked up at CPAC in the gallery lobby on Wednesday, November 1st from 3:00 PM – 4:00 PM.
- Reception on Friday, November 3rd from 5:30 PM – 7:00 PM.
- Artwork will be taken down on Thursday, December 21st from 10:00 AM – 11:00 AM.
